ORCHESTRA PARKING/DIRECTIONS:

Free parking will be available for all musicians in the Brownell Avenue Parking Garage next door to the theater. To access the garage, turn onto Brownell Street, and then take your first right, just past Sher's Automotive Center. **THERE IS NO GARAGE ACCESS FROM WASHINGTON STREET.** Musicians with large instruments can pull up past the garage to drop-off instruments first. An HSO staff member will be on-site to watch instruments while you park. After parking in the garage, exit on the same side of the garage facing the campus (not the side facing Washington Street). Turn right and walk along the side of the building connected to the parking garage (this is the theater). Signs will be out to direct you to the Main Entrance.
